The right moment

Wait until the sun has disappeared deep below the horizon and no longer illuminates the sky.

Choose a night with a new moon because these are particularly dark and offer perfect conditions.

You should also keep an eye on the weather to get a cloudless view of the stars.

The optimal location

Find a place that is as dark as possible, away from brightly lit streets. Rural regions usually offer a suitable environment.

In addition, you have a particularly clear view from hills or in the mountains.

Enough time

Plan enough time because not only the search for a place can take some time, but also your eyes need about 20-30 minutes to get used to the darkness. In the meantime, you should avoid artificial light sources.

Suitable equipment

You don't need a lot for an unforgettable night under the stars. However, make sure that you wear warm clothes, because even on summer nights it can be cold outside.

Having a chair, blanket, and snacks with you can also be a good idea.

Depending on the season, mosquito spray may also be useful.

Additional tools

To orient yourself in the dark without irritating your eyes, you can use a red light flashlight or stick red cellophane on a conventional flashlight.
